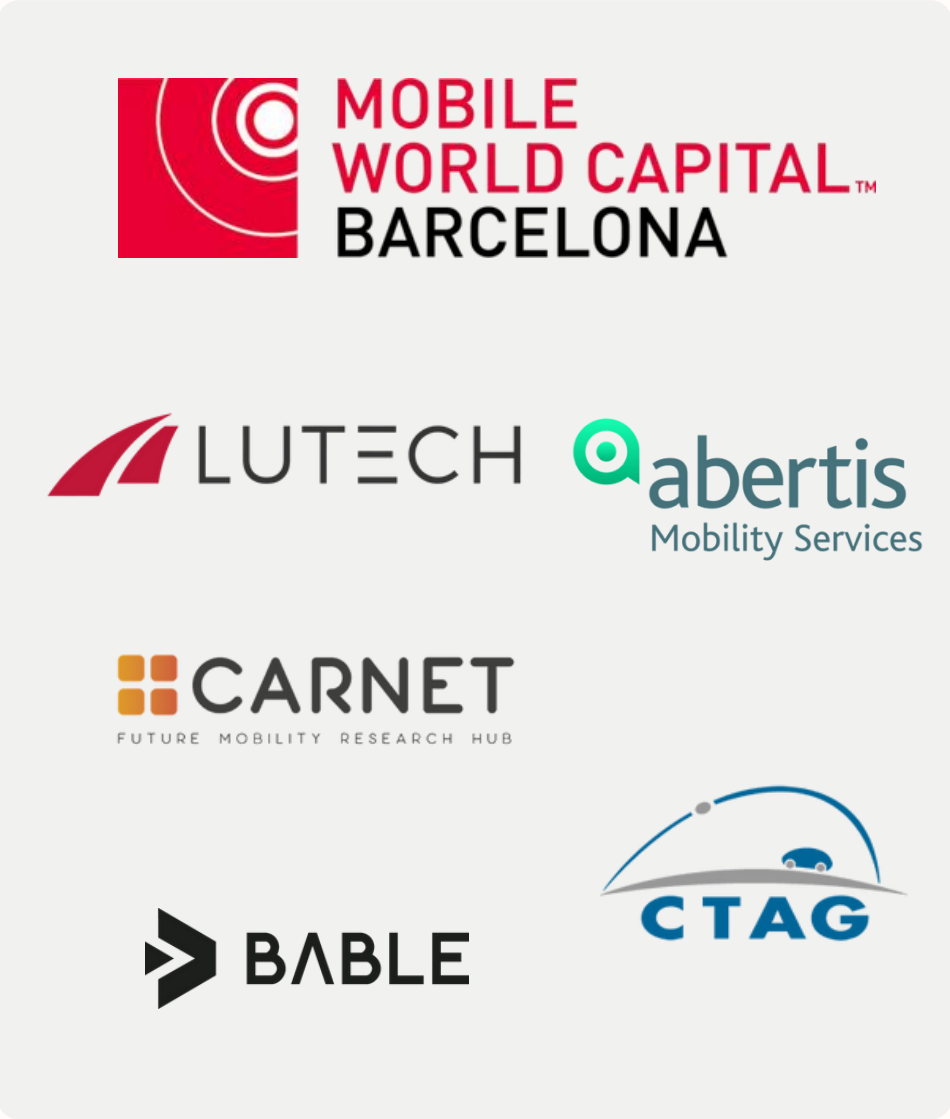

PRM parking spots location

Difficulty finding PRM spots near their destination



Non-accessible, inconsistent regulations

In some areas, parking is paid or time-limited



A local solutions for every city

The local solution that councils propose is not practical



Inadequate asset management

Management of disability parking spots remains fragmented and inefficient, generating extra costs for municipalities.



Rising misuses

Fraudulent permits and unauthorised parking block legitimate users.



PRM parking information offered is very limited

Open data is unavailable or difficult to use, limiting PRM accessibility and mobility

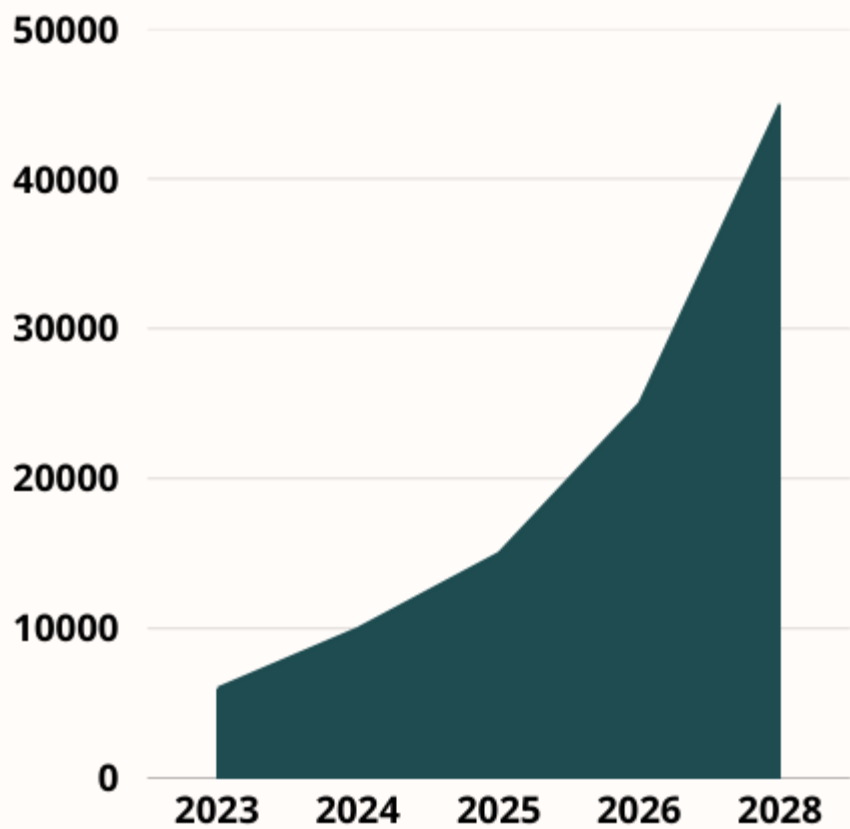

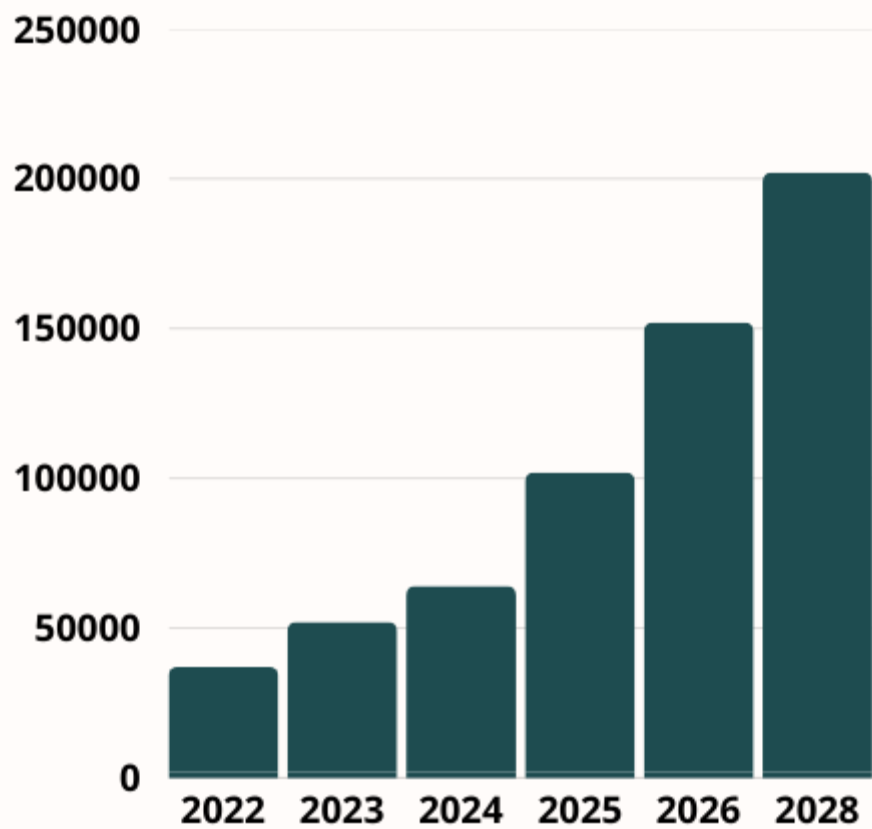
